Two Invitations

We have a lot of exciting things going on at Shalimar United Methodist Church! Let me lift up two opportunities that are potentially very impactful and even transformational. First, we are forming a new 12x12 team. Second, we are offering another opportunity to pray and fast together.

First, we are forming a new 12x12 team. On Wednesday, October 4th, we will have an orientation about what is involved with this opportunity. 12x12 is a journey that focuses on both discipleship and leadership. 12x12 also seeks strategies and plans for team members to form their own teams one year later. The orientation will be at 7:00 pm in FLC Room 106 following the Pastors' Class.

We are seeking around 12 people to be in this year's 12x12 team. Are you interested in being one of those twelve? It is a high commitment but a very rewarding journey. Let me know if you are interested.

Secondly...are you interested in learning more about prayer and fasting? On October 22 and 29 at 1:00 pm we will have teaching sessions about prayer and fasting as a lead into twenty-one days of fasting in November. Dallas Gray will partner with me to teach biblically and physically some of the benefits of fasting. Dallas has an incredible story...last Sunday, some of us heard Dallas share his powerful witness during United Methodist Men's breakfast. Dallas says this about the spiritual discipline of fasting...

"Throughout the Bible we are shown the importance of Prayer and Fasting. Our Lord Jesus told us to Pray and Fast. Prayer connects us to God while fasting disconnects us from the world. Together they bring us into a deep relationship with God renewing and strengthening us: Body, Soul, and Spirit." (Dallas Gray)

We are anticipating around 40 people praying and fasting together for twenty-one days leading up to Thanksgiving. Obviously, Thanksgiving is a feasting time! Are you interested? We would invite you to the teaching sessions on October 22 and 29 at 1:00 pm in the Chapel to learn more. We will use the book *Awakening* by Stovall Weems. Books are available in the office for those interested.

This Week's Guide for Groups & Individuals

There's something powerful about a light in the darkness. If we have a choice between going down a dark path, or a well lit one, most often we will choose the well lit path. Darkness often means the unknown, possible dangers, and getting lost.

In our passage this week, Jesus speaks about being our light, our guidance in life. He wants to show us the way to go and which paths to take. He intends to illuminate the steps directly before but doesn't guarantee we can see to the end of the trail.

Of course, this is a metaphor for our spiritual lives here on earth and also our eternal life after death. Jesus doesn't actually walk around shining lights in certain directions; but he does guide us through Scripture and the Holy Spirit so that we aren't left in the darkness on our own.

Questions for Discussion/Thought

- 1. We sometimes hear people use the expression, "he (or she) is in a dark place." What do people typically mean? §
- 2. How have you experienced Jesus as a source of light in a time of darkness?§
- 3. Unlike the Hebrews in the wilderness, we don't have clouds and fiery pillars to remind us of God's presence. So how can we know that God is with us?†
- 4. How does God's guidance come to you? How has your understanding of this process changed over time? †
- 5. What does it mean for us to be a light for the world?§


