Our Connection at Work

In the coming weeks in October, our congregation will be able to join with other United Methodists and see our connection at work. First, we are invited to help the Hurricane Florence victims. Second, we will be hosting and have an opportunity to hear Reverend Andrés Gonzalez from Cuba. Third, our laity will lead us this upcoming month in the United Methodist tradition of observing Laity Sunday each year. Fourth, everyone is invited to join our Bishop, David Graves, in an upcoming town hall meeting on October 7, 2018 hosted by Navarre United Methodist Church.

If you would like to help the victims in the Carolinas from Hurricane Florence you may give to United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). Make check payable to SUMC and put in memo line UMCOR. UMCOR is already helping respond to the devastation of so many along the Eastern Seaboard. Our United Methodist Church is especially nimble in acting swiftly following disasters through UMCOR. Shalimar is also a collection point for flood buckets (health kits) for our Pensacola District. If you would like to know how to prepare a flood bucket (health kit) you can go to the website www.umcor.org for an instruction guide. There has also been an appeal for rakes, flat blade shovels, and box fans. Karen and I are giving a special offering to UMCOR this week along with our weekly tithe. In the coming weeks, we will keep Shalimar aware of any additional ways we can help.

In a few weeks, October 13-14, Shalimar will host our annual Laity Weekend. We are grateful for the planning of our Lay Leader Beth Russell. This year, after the planning began, we learned Rev. Andrés Gonzalez will be in Shalimar for a visit this weekend. Andrés is the pastor of our sister church First United Methodist Church in Ceigo, Cuba. Our Cuba Mission team has been instrumental in helping our sister church in the last five years in Cuba. Pastor Andrés will bring the message at our Saturday Night Service (October 13) and our 11:07 service (October 14). He will also speak during our Sunday School hour in the Family Life Center. We look forward to hearing from our laity and pastor Andrés during this special weekend.

Our Bishop, David Graves, will be leading a town hall meeting for the Pensacola District on October 7, 2018. The event will be held at 3:00 pm and hosted by Navarre United Methodist Church. I would like to encourage our lay leadership to attend. I would also like to invite anyone wanting to know about the upcoming special called session of General Conference in St. Louis in February. 
