On January 28th, your Church Council approved a Master Plan concept for an improved SUMC campus, and a timeline for a Fall 2019 Capital Campaign to fund the building project.

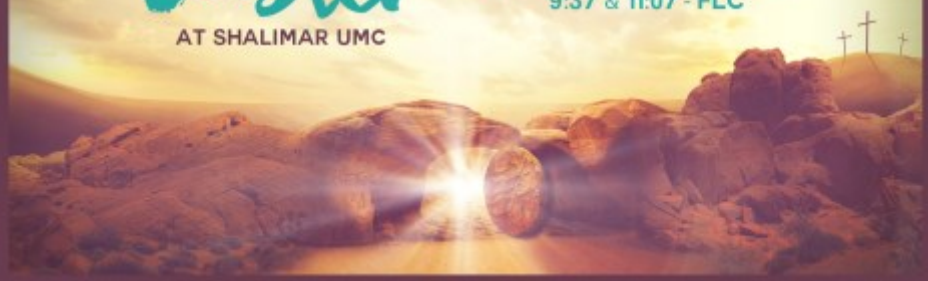
